# <u>Classroom Expectations – 8th Grade Math</u> Ms. A. Schubach (24-25)

\*No cell phones during class unless directed to use them.

### For Class:

- 1) <u>Homework</u> is done daily and due at the beginning of the period. It will count as a completion grade. **YOU** are expected to make corrections in a different color.
- 2) If you are <u>absent</u>, you will be given time to make up work without penalty. As per the school guidelines, the number of days absent EQUALS the number of days you get to make up work. <u>USE CLASSROOM</u> to help you get caught up. Notes and homework will always be posted on the page.
- 3) All work is to be shown on homework, quizzes and tests or little to no credit will be given. Everything will be graded in the same manner as State Test expectations.
- 4) You will be taking notes every day. Please use them when completing homework and studying for assessments. Notes will also be posted to the Classroom page. Please use that if you feel you miss something OR are making up back work from being absent.
- 5) You will be expected to STUDY on your own again this year. I will outline what you need to study, but you need to go back to old homework questions, cover up the correct work and see if you can answer the questions again. It is essential that you work on this skill this year! I will remind you to study, we will talk about what that looks like, but the expectation is that YOU, do the extra work needed to study and prepare for exams.
- 6) Bring your materials with you to class: 3-Ring binder with notes pages, folder, pens, pencil and calculator.
- 7) If you are having trouble, please let me know sooner rather than later so we can fix things quickly. ASK questions in class!

#### Calculators:

We use Scientific calculators (TI 30IIa or other varieties.). Texas Instrument works best for what you need and has all the required calculator keys. NOT ALL CALCULATORS are the same, so please check! I only have a few school calculators that I can issue for use during the year. So please plan accordingly. You will not need them for the first 2 weeks of school.

## **Grading:**

### Homework – 40% Assessments – 60% \*as per district policy
