- 1. Homework is done daily **and** in pencil.
- 2. Homework is due at the beginning of each class. Students will be responsible for grading their own homework and making corrections. No late work will be accepted. (Students who are legally absent will be given time to make up work without a penalty. The number of days absent = the number of days allowed to make up work).
- 3. All work is to be shown on homework, quizzes and tests or little to no credit will be given. The process leading to the answer is more important in most situations than the answers.
- 4. Students will need to take the class notes every day and use them when doing their homework. We will be working on keeping an organized binder and use it as a study tool.
- 5. All materials need to be brought to class every day: binder, pencil, and a graphing calculator.
