#### **Course Overview:**

The purpose of this course is to provide the student with a well-rounded survey of United States and New York State History. Grade 8 Social Studies is arranged chronologically, beginning with Reconstruction and ending at the present, and incorporates geography as well as economic, social and political trends. The course content is divided into nine Key Ideas; the first seven trace the human experience in the United States from Reconstruction to the end of World War II. The last three Key Ideas examine different themes in United States and New York State history from the post-War period up to the present day, which provides the opportunity to explore contemporary issues.

#### **Class Procedures**

Class begins when the bell rings! NO EXCEPTIONS! Students MUST have a pass if they are late. Come to every class prepared! Bring notebooks, pencils, and have any completed assignments if assigned.

The day's agenda will be posted in the classroom. Follow the instructions.

## **Homework Policy**
