1) Homework is done daily (in pencil, corrections in pen) Homework is due at the beginning of each class. It will be a completion grade. Students are expected to make corrections and ask questions.
2) All work is to be shown on homework, quizzes and tests or little to no credit will be given.
3) Students will need to take the class notes every day and use them when doing their homework. We will be working on keeping an organized notebook this year and learn how to use it as a study tool.
4) All materials need to be brought to class everyday: textbook, notebook, folder, pencils and a scientific calculator.
