We are pleased to provide a summary of the bid results for your capital project. As you know, we took bids originally on April 23, 2018. The EC and PC bids were within budget, the GC bid was slightly over budget, and the MC bid was significantly over budget. Upon review and discussions with your attorney, it was decided to re-bid the GC and MC portions of the project. Over the last few weeks the documents were repackaged, and the PC work was incorporated into the GC scope of work (eliminating the need for a PC). On May 16, 2018, a total of three (3) General Construction bids and two (2) Mechanical bids were received for the re-bid. Along with the total of three (3) electrical bids that were received in the original bid, and upon review and discussion, we offer the apparent low bidders are as follows:
