


Chosen books are applicable to most, if not all, the content areas



- A Long Way Gone: Memoirs of a Boy Soldier (grades 9-12)
  - Health (drug addiction, diet, all forms of abuse, mental health, rehabilitation, PTSD), Science (biomes), Math (distance), ELA (literary elements, story telling, memoir), Social Studies (geography, world history, foreign policy, psychology, sociology, war, culture), PE (walking), Art/ Music (Soukous music, rap, African native art), , 21st Century Skills (Global Awareness)

## • A Long Walk to Water (grades 5-8)

• Math (distance, volume), Science (what is in the water, biomes, mass,




